All 3-5 students in the CMS district will begin taking the End of Grade (EOG) Tests on Monday, May 10th - Wednesday, May 12th. Our school will need volunteers to proctor (assist) teachers or test administrators during testing beginning at 8:45 a.m. - 11:45 a.m. If volunteers are not able to proctor for the entire duration of the testing period, they may be assigned to a kindergarten room to assist teachers as their normal assistants will be used as proctors for the three hour time frame. If anyone is available or desire to participate, please have them go to the CMS homepage at <http://www.cms.k12.nc.us/> to complete the volunteer application. It takes approximate 1-2 minutes to complete and is approved within 2-3 business day. Additionally, send me the names of any interested parties and their available time. What time they are able to volunteer is useful.
