As are enjoying our 35th year of serving our community, the Mint Hill Women's Club continues to promote activities that exhibit the vision of Service, Social, Self-improvement.

CLUB HISTORY

In September 1974, a neighborhood organization began, and was soon named the Farmwood Women's Auxiliary. The purpose of this group was:

- **to promote civic involvement,**
- **to raise money to put back into the community and**
- **to share social and cultural interests with residents of the Farmwood community.**

Over the years the name changed to Farmwood Women's Club, Farmwood Friends & Neighbors and in 2005, **Mint Hill Women's Club**, as the scope of membership expanded.

In our 35 year history we have contributed over \$80,000 back to the community. Some of the most noteworthy recipients of our contributions include:

• 56 Senior Scholarships (Independence & Butler High Schools - CPCC)	\$ 29,000
• Mint Hill Fire & Ambulance Squad	15,000
• Idlewild Fire Department	6,400
• Mint Hill Library	3,500
• Mint Hill Police	4,900
• Mint Hill Town Parks	2,400
• Mint Hill Historical Society	2,500
• Levine Senior Center	1,500

The club not only participates with monetary donations to worthwhile endeavors but also with the unselfish gift of our time to a wide variety of causes.

Over the history of the club, it is estimated that over 15,000 hours have been given in support of: ASID Home, Shelter for Battered Women, Nursing Homes, Crisis Assistance Ministry, Mint Hill Madness, Alexander Youth Center, etc. We have made a concerted effort to recognize our men and women who serve the military.

Our primary funds have been raised through annual LIVE/Silent Auction. Also, through other activities such as making and selling crafts, quilt raffles, and card. Through the years we have sponsored attic sales, as well as, cookbook, plant and pecan sales.

Needless to say, the Club has been quite active and productive in our community!

The Club also encourages participation in day "Field Trips" and home & garden tours. Bridge, gourmet, book and other clubs have been organized as a byproduct of the club.

We strive to support other local organizations (i.e., Mint Hill Arts Council, NC Korean War Memorial, Mint Hill Lions Club, Lawyers Glen Retirement).
